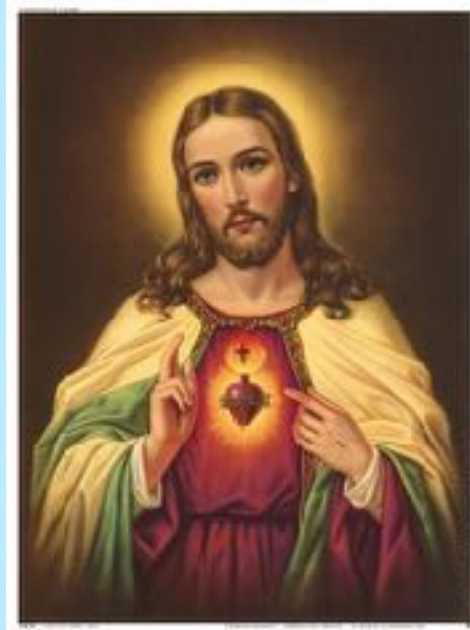

Rest in His Heart

Continuing on the theme for this month: the Sacred Heart: A common practice since the promotion of this devotion throughout the 17th century and into the 19th century when Pius IX made it a universal feast has been to consecrate one’s home and self to Christ’s Sacred Heart and to have an image placed in one’s home. This is connected to one of the promises Christ has made to those who have a devotion to His Sacred Heart, that is: “I will establish peace in their homes,” and it also helps to establish and show that one’s house is a Catholic home. In order to foster this devotion I will include the individual prayer of consecration below along with a small image that may be cut out. However, if anyone would like a more durable image to place, let me know and I can retrieve one.

“O Sacred Heart of Jesus, to Thee I consecrate and offer up my person and my life, my actions, trials, and sufferings, that my entire being may henceforth only be employed in loving, honoring and glorifying Thee. This is my irrevocable will, to belong entirely to Thee, and to do all for Thy love, renouncing with my whole heart all that can displease Thee.

I take Thee, O Sacred Heart, for the sole object of my love, the protection of my life, the pledge of my salvation, the remedy of my frailty and inconstancy, the reparation for all the defects of my life, and my secure refuge at the hour of my death. Be Thou, O Most Merciful Heart, my justification before God Thy Father, and screen me from His anger which I have so justly merited. I fear all from my own weakness and malice, but placing my entire confidence in Thee, O Heart of Love, I hope all from Thine infinite Goodness. Annihilate in me all that can displease or resist Thee. Imprint Thy pure love so deeply in my heart that I may never forget Thee or be separated from Thee.

I beseech Thee, through Thine infinite Goodness, grant that my name be engraved upon Thy Heart, for in this I place all my happiness and all my glory, to live and to die as one of Thy devoted servants. Amen.” - St. Margaret Mary Alacoque

New Family Catechesis

Parents will have lots of help along the way with an At-Home Guide and sessions broken down step by step. For those with multiple children at different grade levels there is instructions on how to teach them together.
